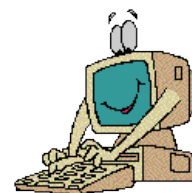
WELCOME BACK!!

Important Reminders

- Places must be paid for **in advance on a weekly or monthly basis** unless otherwise arranged with the manager. Failure to pay all outstanding fees by the end of the month will result in your account being frozen until the balance is paid and will incur additional costs. **Please be aware that if you are using the Go Cardless system on the Libacura site, it can take 7—10 days to reach our account**
- Please can parents remember to sign their child/ren in and out of the club so that we have an up to date record of who is in the club in the event of an evacuation.
- We are privileged to be able to have the use of the school car park but this is only until 8.15am before school and after 3.45pm after school. Can we also please remind parents to be aware of their speed coming into and out of the school gates and also on Timberley Drive as there have been instances of cars driving at excessive speed whilst there are children outside playing
- Breakfast is only available until 8.20 am and only in term time
- Our cancellation policy now requires **10 working days notice via email**.
